Introduction

The Beyond Gender Stereotypes (BGS) programme supports key stage 2 pupils to understand and challenge limiting gender stereotypes. BGS provides two short units of learning for all KS2 pupils: three 1-hour lessons for Years 3 and 4, and four 1-hour lessons for Years 5 and 6, delivered as part of PSHE.



Online Training Courses

The BGS programme includes self-guided online training courses to equip teachers and other school staff with the skills and knowledge you need to implement BGS effectively in your school, to strengthen your own professional development, and to guide your school to engage effectively with parents and carers to build support for BGS and encourage them to promote its objectives.

All school staff have a role to play, and there are three different versions of the online training course designed specifically for the following groups of staff:

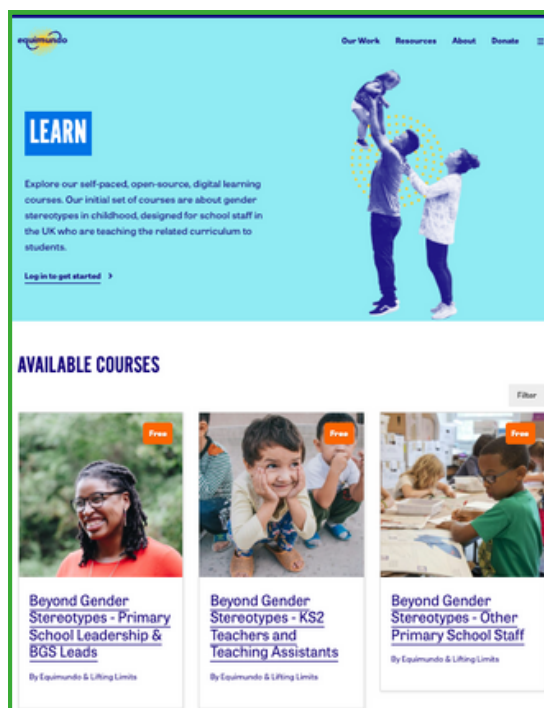

You will then see the following page:

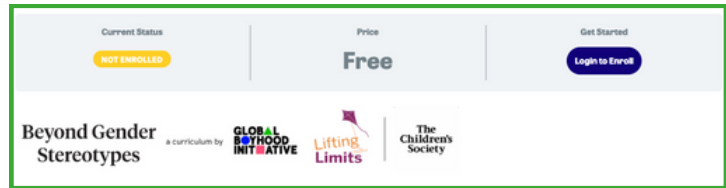
1. Please click on the relevant course associated with your role at school.

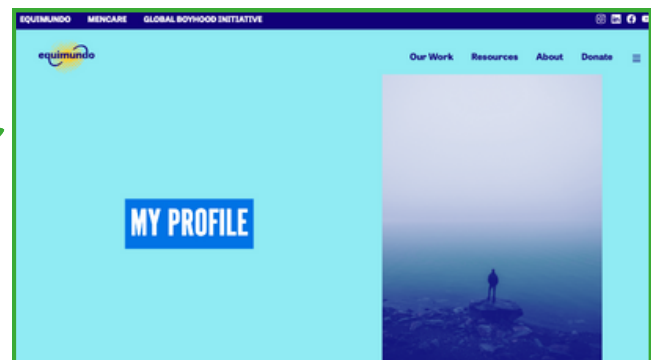
4. This will take you to this page:

You will be asked for your name and email address, and you will need to create a username and password. Please use the name (first name, last name) as you wish it to appear on your Course Completion Certificate. You will need to use these details every time you log in.

5. Once you have registered, you will automatically have access to all the Beyond Gender Stereotypes courses. Initially, you will see this:

Scroll down until you see the icon for your course. When you click on the icon, this will give you access to the course, which you should complete at your own pace, starting with the Pre-Training Survey.



Technical Difficulties

If you experience technical difficulties during registration or when trying to log back in, here are some steps that can help you troubleshoot the issue:

1. Please try clearing your internet cache, then reloading the registration page.
2. If this does not work, please try opening the registration page on another browser (eg, Google Chrome, Firefox etc).
3. If you have successfully registered but find you cannot log back in, please try to re-enter your correct username and password.

If you have difficulty accessing any of the content (e.g. videos) while undertaking the course:

- Check if your school's internet network has a block on any websites you are struggling to access (e.g. YouTube). If so, can you ask your school's IT manager if it is possible to adjust the school's internet filtering and access permissions?
- If this does not work, can you try using your home computer or home wifi network?

If you still experience the technical difficulty after trying the relevant steps above, please contact the BGS Lead at your school with more details about the issue (including screenshots of what happens when you try to register, log back in, etc).
